#### Theo


"It was enjoyable to not only participate in the activities but also to teach the younger years as we could see their progress throughout the different activities."





Floating in the deep waters, swimming on, I rise. Flooding, splashing, bashing like the shallow waves, I rise.


Like an elephant waving its tusks around, like a cheetah hearing a wild gazelle sound.
