Dear Parents and Carers

It was lovely to welcome children through the gates once more as we started our new academic year. There were lots of children who had grown over the summer and everyone looked smart in their new uniform. I felt incredibly proud in my morning assembly on Monday as I saw children entering respectfully showcasing and that excellent behaviour. Walking around the school later, there was a lovely buzz of learning with children forging new and exciting learning partners in their classes. A huge thank you to all the Speenhamland staff who worked so tirelessly over the summer to ensure everything was ready for the children.

To help encourage independence and ownership with our pupils, I politely ask that parents remember the arrangements for dropping off in the morning. It is only our new EYFS parents that should be bringing their children onto the playground for dropoff. From year 1 onwards, we expect our pupils to walk in by themselves. If you have particular messages you wish to pass on to the teacher, the senior leadership team will be available every morning. 


