#### **PUPILS' AMAZING WORK THIS WEEK!**




This week, the children in Wisteria Class have enjoyed learning about dentists and discussing what foods are good for our teeth











Mehreen, from Cherry Class, wrote a poem based on the Desk Diddler, which the children have been working on in English.
