As you are aware from daily press releases, the Covid numbers across the country are continuing to grow.

Please can I remind you of the following:
If your child tests positive for Covid over the
Christmas holiday period, please can you

If your child is identified as a close contact or someone in the household tests positive, the government recommend lateral flow testing for 7 days as well as a one off PCR.

Parents of school-age children as well as secondary school children, are recommended to lateral flow test twice a week

Cherry Class did some sewing this week and made Christmas tree decorations.







Cedar, Acer and Redwood have been planting a new hedgerow on the school field this week after being given saplings from the Queen's Canopy project.







