Spring Term 2 in Reception

SPEENHAMLAND

Maths

In Maths, we will continue looking at the composition of numbers, and different ways we can partition the number 6 and 7. Children will begin to understand doubles as well as positional language. We will finish with identifying shapes in the environment.

Literacy

During our literacy lessons, we will focus on Fantastic Foundations, where children have a focus book for the week. Children will explore a few pages at a time, undertaking immersive sessions to promote discussion before writing simple phrases. They will begin to write short sentences.

Science

This term, we will be exploring life cycles, with a particular focus on the life cycle of a butterfly. We will be creating a life cycle booklet as we observe the metamorphosis of a caterpillar, comparing this to the life cycle of a human.

DT

This term, we will be introducing woodwork to the children. They will be shown how to identify and safely use a hammer, saw and screwdriver. These sessions will be a 1:3 ratio with a teacher, with the exception of using a saw which will be 1:1. This knowledge will be used to design and create their own toys cars.

Music

This term, we will continue looking at a variety of songs, exploring how they make us feel. During our lessons, we will continue to use glockenspiels and develop our ability to find a pulse and keep a beat.

<u>PE</u>

During PE, we will be looking at exploring the gym equipment even further with Mr Page. We will continue our exploration of different ways of moving.

Geography

In our Geography lessons we will be exploring our planet, looking closely at what it is made of as well as what our country is called and what our capital city is. We will work towards creating a map showing key landmarks in our local area.

Art

This term the children will be exploring pattern and the work of Piet Mondrian. Looking at his use of primary colours and shape in his art work, before recreating our own Piet Mondrian inspired art work.

PSHE

During our PSHE lessons, we will look at what it means to be healthy, exploring diet and exercise.

<u>RE</u>

In our RE lessons, we will be exploring the meaning behind Easter and why it is celebrated by Christians.
