

"My best bit was singing We Three Kings"




"I enjoyed being 'Angel Gabe' and singing Starry Night".




This week in Reception, the children have shown great team work.

During house building with crates, the children worked together.


When conflicts arose, they worked through these to help support collaboration and working with others respectfully.
