There was also 195 learning minutes lost this week through late arrivals.




PUPIL'S AMAZING WORK

his week in Reception we have looked at the book, 'All are Welcome Here' by Alexandra Penfold, which explores diversity. It's allowed the children to learn about how we are different and the same. We started to learn about the English FANTASTICS lenses, feeling, asking, noticing, touching and action to familiarise ourselves with the symbols when exploring texts. We also practised to subitising 1, 2 and 3 to be able to recognise these amounts in different ways. The dots on a dice support this, as the children become familiar with the patterns. Isaac, Layla, Billy and Lincoln also enjoyed being firefighters and putting out the fires and lots of children have been interested in making mud-kitchen recipes and faces with natural materials.
