





HEADTEACHER'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents and Carers

This week has gone so quickly. It seems we are racing to the end of term. It was great to welcome our new EYFS parents this week to two sessions, so that they could begin to get to know our school. I was delighted to be able to share with them the plans for our new EYFS and Keevill provision. Next academic year, we have been very fortunate to gain the Pelican Nursery building for our school. This means that our EYFS provision will be moving to the purpose-built accommodation, which is currently being refurbished by West Berkshire Council on our behalf. We are very excited about this new development, as it will increase the space for our EYFS children to learn and play. Once we have moved into this block, the current EYFS area will be redeveloped in to a new space for the Keevill. We have been waiting a long time for this development but are extremely pleased that it is all now taking shape. We are working with the Council on a daily basis to finalise dates for the move. As soon as we know more, I will keep you informed.

Next week, we have our Sports Day on Wednesday 30th June. Please remember that your child should come to school dressed in their PE kit and if they would like to wear a coloured top to represent their house, then they can do so. Junior Sports Day will take place in the morning with EYFS and Infants Sports Day in the afternoon.
