Subscription to the West Berkshire School Sports Network	£3,885.00	Mr A Page attended three CPD courses as part of this affiliation, he qualified as a Nordic Walking instructor and is now trained to deliver Real PE and Real Gym PE lessons. All three of these courses are designed to increase the engagement of pupils during physical activity. Additionally the School Sports Network has provided 149 opportunities for children to represent their school in interschool activities.
Arranging and Hosting sports events	No cost	Provided 88 opportunities for children to represent their school in interschool activities. Many of these opportunities were given to children who don't frequently represent the school.
Affiliation to Newbury District Primary Schools Football Association	£165	Provided 91 opportunities for children to represent their school in interschool activities across 11 different competitions to include all age groups and genders in the junior school.
Affiliation to Newbury District Primary Schools Netball Association	£30	Provided 19 opportunities for children to represent their school in interschool activities.
Affiliation to Newbury District Primary Schools Swimming Association	£928	36 children attended a 10 week block of swimming lessons. These children were in years 4, 5 or 6 and hadn't previously succeeded in swimming 25 metres. 27.5% of these children achieved the target of 25 metres after the 10 weeks of lessons. Additionally this affiliation has provided 30 opportunities for children to represent their school in an interschool swim gala. The events included opportunities for all age groups and genders across the junior school.
Affiliation to Team Kennet Athletics package	£30	Provided 26 opportunities for children to represent their school in interschool activities.
Purchasing of sports equipment	£6,491.64	Allowed a wider variety of sports to be taught within school and during after school club. The Keevill unit also purchased an exercise machine which assists with a full body exercise.
Real PE & Real Gym resources	£1,192.80	These resources provide a full curriculum for the whole school, as of the next academic year all classes will have two PE lessons a week, one of which will be a Real PE or Real Gym lesson. These lessons will focus on teaching the children the fundamental movements and physical literacy skills to enable faster progression.
Nordic Walking poles	£664.24	Provided 30 opportunities for children to experience Nordic Walking as part of a lunchtime club. Nordic Walking is a low impact and low energy sport, this encouraged some children to participate in sport. Additionally 20 children also had the opportunity to experience Nordic Walking in the local area.
12 weeks of GKR Karate lessons	£864	Provided 15 opportunities for children to attend an hour long Karate club once a week. This club targeted PPG and EAL children.
Repairs to adventure playground	£933	Provides a safe and enjoy piece of equipment for all children to use the adventure playground. All year groups have a break and lunch period on the adventure playground.
Educational visit to Bath University	£100	Provides 10 gifted and talented children the opportunity to visit a university and learn more about higher level sport and use some of the facilities provided.
Develop leadership of sport in school	No cost	Our school sports captains and ambassadors provide opportunities for younger children to have access to sporting activities during lunchtimes and through an after school club. (80 children attended the after school club across 5 weeks)
