Monday - Wednesday

Literacy- What were some of the fruits that Handa put in her basket to take to her friend? Can you write a list of them? You can draw pictures to match if you like! Then we would like you to take your list and go to the shops!

Maths investigation- Can you ask Mummy or Daddy if they have these coins? Can you order them from smallest value to biggest?



Maths- These are the cost of the items in Mrs Choudhury's shop- not Sainsburys sadly. Which coins could you use to make the total?



UW- In the story of Handa's Surprise, Handa has some more unusual fruits in her basket, these grow well in Africa because it is very hot! We would like you to use your list and buy some of these in the shop. When you get home, have a taste, can you describe what it tasted like? What were your favourites? What did you dislike? Why?

Reading- Write down the words below on individual pieces of paper or get an adult to do it for you. Then can you sort out the words to make the sentences make sense? Who took the banana? Which fruit did the zebra take? You may need to watch the story again. Don't forget to look carefully to use the capital letter at the beginning of your sentence and full stop at the end.

Writing- Watch this video from BBC Bitesize all about Kenya, we know from the story of Handa's Surprise what food grows there and some animals that live there but what does Kenya look like compared to where we live? Can you write down at least 3 differences you spot from watching the video? Can you write down 2 things that are the same?

UW and EAD- Lots of animals live in Kenya, there are many fabulous safari animals, some big and some small. What is your favourite safari animal? We would like you to make one, you can use any material! How will you stick it together? What will you materials will you use? There are some ideas below but please be as creative as you wish!



Maths investigation- Using the lovely fruit that you bought earlier in the week, we would like you cut the banana's, oranges and pineapple in half very carefully using a knife with support. Can you cut them in half again? How many pieces do you have now? Can you do the same with the other fruits?

Maths- This week we simply want you to practice counting, recognising and ordering numbers to 20. On individual pieces of paper, can you write one number each to 20. Can you get an adult to hide them around your house and go on a number hunt? Once you have found them all. Can you put them in the correct order? You can play this a couple of times to practice!

PSED- In the story Handa collects fruit for her friend as a surprise. I am sure you are missing some of your friends at the moment. When you see them again, what would you take them as a surprise? Maybe you could draw a picture and label it with your idea.
