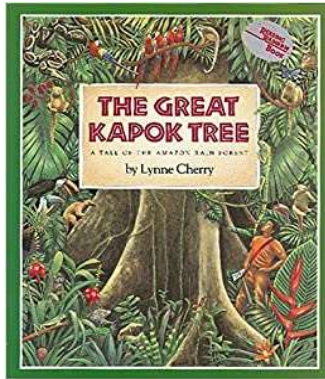


Home Learning EYFS Week Beginning: 15th June 2020

Literacy- What were some of the animals that visited the man in the rainforest? Can you write a list of them? You can draw pictures to match if you like!

UW- Can you watch this video about Brazil

Can you write down three things that are different or that you have seen in the video or found out from other sources and that you now know about Brazil?

Maths - We are doubling again this week! Can you solve these problems to find the answers?

-Go find three leaves outside, collect 3 more! How many do you have now?

-Sophie made 6 cupcakes for her friends in class but there are double that amount! How many more would you need and how many altogether?

-Find 9 sticks! If you found 9 more, how many would you have?

-There are 10 children in class but today there are double that amount, how many altogether?



EAD- Each year in Rio, Brazil the Rio Carnival is held where samba dancing and dressing up takes place. It is a huge show that is famous around the world and the people in it practice a year before the event to get ready for it! We are making them at school and hope to upload a photo to Tapestry at the end of the week so everyone can see!



Writing- Watch this video from BBC Bitesize all about Kenya, we know from the story of Handa's Surprise what food grows there and some animals that live there but what does Kenya look like compared to where we live? Can you write down at least 3 differences you spot from watching the video? Can you write down 2 things that are the same?

UW and EAD- Lots of animals live in the Amazon rainforest, some big and some small. Refer to the first page of the story or if you are watching the video, pause the video where it shows a picture of the different layers of the rainforest. In a rainforest, it is so thick and there are so many trees that different animals live in different parts of the forest and each part has a different name. Let the children look at the picture and ask who do you think lives in the emergent layer (very top), Canopy (top), Understory (middle), Forest Floor (bottom). Can you have a go at drawing a rainforest picture yourself?

EAD- What is your favourite animal from the story? We would like you to draw a picture of it, you can use paint, pens or pencil to colour it in!



Maths investigation- We are halving again this week! Can you solve these problems to find the answers?

- April made 8 cookies and ate half of them! How many did she eat? How many were left?
- Draw 4 bottles of paint, colour half of the bottles in! How many are coloured in?
- There are 12 children in Class 3, half of them are girls and half are boys. How many girls and how many boys?
- There are 10 children in class but today there are double that amount, how many altogether?

Maths- Can you draw a triangle, square, diamond, circle, rectangle and semi circle. Can you cut them out carefully using scissors? Can you cut the shapes in half?
